Each year, the Children's Dyslexia Center of Oriskany offers intensive training in Multisensory Structured Language Education, also referred to as Orton-Gillingham. In this course, which results in certification through IMSLEC as a Level 1 Dyslexia Practitioner, you will gain in-depth theoretical and practical knowledge about how students learn to read and how to help them when they struggle. Participants only pay for their textbooks and materials which is approximately \$250. There is also an option to earn 6 graduate credits through the Ashland University). Upon certification, trainees are eligible to apply for a paid tutor position at the Center.

- The training cycle begins in mid-July and continues for approximately one year.
- Course requirements include:
 - 90 seminar hours (3 weekdays in July, 3 Saturdays in the fall, and 1 Saturday in the spring)
- 100 supervised practicum hours (2.5 hours after school on M/W or T/Th at the Center, October through May)
